

PRUDENTIAL VIETNAM'S SANCTIONS COMPLIANCE NOTICE

Prudential Vietnam Assurance Private Limited ("Prudential") is committed to complying with applicable Group requirements and sanctions regulations imposed by international organizations, governmental authorities, and regulatory bodies both within and outside Vietnam, including but not limited to the United Nations Security Council (UNSC), the UK Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI), the U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC), the Hong Kong Monetary Authority (HKMA), and other relevant sanctions authorities (the "Sanctions Regulations"). Under the Sanctions Regulations, individuals and entities are prohibited from engaging in transactions, providing financial support, or offering services to sanctioned individuals, entities, or activities. Failure to comply with applicable Sanctions Regulations may result in civil liability, criminal liability, administrative penalties, or a combination thereof.

Accordingly, to ensure compliance with applicable Sanctions Regulations, Prudential does not establish or maintain customer or business partner relationships, provide insurance products or services, process transactions, or facilitate transactions involving individuals or entities located in, or otherwise connected with, sanctioned countries and territories.

The countries and territories currently subject to sanctions restrictions include:

- Crimea region of Ukraine
- Donetsk People's Republic (Ukraine)
- Kherson People's Republic (Ukraine)
- Zaporizhzhia People's Republic (Ukraine)
- Luhansk People's Republic (Ukraine)
- Cuba
- Iran
- Democratic People's Republic of Korea (North Korea)
- Syria.
